RE: Compliance with American Iron and Steel (AIS)

ASC Profiles LLC certifies that its ASC Steel Deck products are manufactured in the United States and can comply with the American Iron and Steel (AIS) requirement that steel must be poured and melted in the U.S.

ASC Steel Deck must be informed at bid time that the steel must comply with domestic content compliance regulations required by AIS as additional lead times and costs may apply. Please note that unless you give ASC Steel Deck notice at the time of your request for a quote, the standard inventoried steel used to produce our panels will not comply with AIS requirements.

ASC Steel Deck quotations can also include incidental components acquired from various sources that may not be manufactured in the United States. These incidental components are low-cost, miscellaneous components (nuts, bolts, other fasteners, etc.) that represent a very small percentage of the total cost of materials delivered by ASC Steel Deck. Although the exact product list may not be known at the time the bid is submitted, the expectation is that the cost of components manufactured outside the United States would be between 0% and 5% of the total cost of materials.

Please notify your ASC Steel Deck Representative when requesting a quote if your project must comply with AIS requirements.
