RE: Compliance with Domestic Content Regulations, including Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA)

ASC Profiles LLC certifies that its ASC Steel Deck products are manufactured in the United States and can comply with the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA) requirements under Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("IIJA"), Pub. L. 177-58, as well as other domestic content regulations.

ASC Steel Deck must be informed when requesting a quote if the order must comply with BABAA requirements and any other domestic content regulations, as additional lead times and costs may apply. Please specify that domestic steel is required and clearly indicate this on the quote and purchase order.

ASC Steel Deck quotations may include incidental components that may not be manufactured in the United States. These incidental components are low-cost items, like flashings and profile closures, and represent a very small percentage of the total cost of materials delivered by ASC Steel Deck. Although the exact product list may not be known when the bid is submitted, the expectation is that the cost of components manufactured outside the United States would be between 0% and 5% of the total cost of materials. These components may be subject to commercially available off-the-shelf (COTS) item exceptions or qualify for a non-availability waiver under applicable domestic content regulations.

Please notify your ASC Steel Deck Representative when requesting a quote if your project must comply with any domestic content regulations.
